ADMISSION

A candidate seeking admission to any of the courses must possess the required qualification from a recognized school or college. The Application form will be available along with the prospectus from the college office on payment of Rs.300/- (Three hundred)

PROCEDURE

- i. Registration can be done through offline mode from the college office.
- ii. To avail free admission and concession registration is mandatory.
- iii. Admission will be on first come first serve basis.
- iv. Registration and prospectus fee will be Rs. 300/-.

ADMISSION OFFER

- i. Free admission for 7 days from the date of declaration of NBSE class 12 result.
- ii. 50% concession for 5 days from the date the free admission gets over.
- iii. 25% concession for 5 days from the date the 50% concession gets over.
- iv. Some seats are reserved for candidates with outstanding academic record, sports persons and differently abled persons.
- v. Free hostel admission for the first 20 boys and 20 girls only.

ATTENDANCE

Students are required to attend all the lectures, tutorials, practical sessions, extension lectures and other programmes arranged for them. A student whose attendance falls below 80% will not be allowed to appear the pre and end semester examination.

- i. Leaving the college premises during the class hours will not be permited except when the cause is sudden illness or some unforseen circumstance.
- ii. To be admitted to the classroom, absentees must show the teacher their leave record duly countersigned by the Principal/ Vice Principal/ Dean Students Welfare.
- iii. No student is allowed to leave the college during college hours without approval from the Principal/Vice Principal.

EXAMINATIONS

It is compulsory for all the students to sit for their internal assessments and presemester examination. Students who fail in their internal assessments and presemester examination cannot sit for the end semester examination. Progress reports will be sent to the parents to appraise them regarding the progress of their children.


GENERAL DISCIPLINE

STUDENTS AFFAIRS AND AWARDS

ATTENDANCE AWARD

Students maintaining an aggregate of 100% attendance in each class are eligible for the award. It carries a certificate and cash incentives.

MERITORIOUS AWARD

Meritorious Award is given to those students who secure first position with first division marks. The award carries a memento and cash incentives.

AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

Students securing the highest marks in a particular subject in the End Semester Examination are eligible for the award. It carries a cash award and citation.

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

B.A and B.com 1st semester students securing 75% or more in the HSSLC examination can avail the college scholarship. Two students each in BA and B.com 1st Semester can avail college scholarship and the selection will be based on merit. Selected students will get 50% off in their tuition fee in the 1st semester and that will continue in the subsequent semesters only if the student continues to secure 75% in the End Semester examination.

SPECIAL CATEGORY STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIP

Special category students scholarship was introduced in 2016 for the degree students; one each from B.A & B.Com. The main objective of the scholarship is to provide opportunities to students from economically weaker background, who have an aptitude for good academic performance, with academic record of a minimum of 75% in the HSSLC examination. The scholarship gives free tuition fees. The scholarship is sponsored by the college's teaching and non-teaching staff.

Both college and special category scholarship students should maintain a minimum 80% attendance to avail the scholarship.

SKILL FEST

Empowering the youth to be sustainable and productive by taking the hidden potential of our younger generation and bridging them with the available resources of the state is the core aim of the Skill Fest.

EXPOSURE TRIP

For the final year degree students local exposure trip to a practical field of interest is organized on priority basis.
