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PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Oriental College, Kohima is a private institution, established in 1996 by a group of enthusiastic, energetic men under the auspices of the Christian Youth Organization of Christian Revival Church, Kohima Village. Christian Youth Organization is registered under Registration of Societies Act, 1969 and numbered as H/RS-4958 dated 25th January 2008. The University Grants Commission have granted recognition to the college under section 2 (f) and 12 (b) of the UGC Act, 1956 on 7th July 2011. The College is a sprawling, scenic and serene institution catering to the needs and demands of higher education in Nagaland. The campus spreads over a vast stretch of land measuring about 5.20 acres and is located below the East Circular Road about 1.4 Km from the main city Kohima.

The college provides life skills and personality development as well as skill development training. This is done in order to inculcate life-values and upgrade their skills and talents and to prepare the students to live holistic, well rounded lives.

The college has a library, computer laboratory and recreation facilities like gymnasium, indoor stadium for badminton, table tennis as well as a day care centre. The faculty consists of highly qualified and experienced teachers who are not only committed in helping the students in their academic pursuits but also in mentoring and shaping their future.

ADMISSION

A candidate seeking admission to any of the courses must possess the required qualification from a recognized school or college. The Application form will be available along with the prospectus from the college office on payment of Rs.300/- (Three hundred)

PROCEDURE

- Registration can be done offline mode from the college office.
- To avail free admission and concession registration is mandatory.
- Admission will be on first come first served basis.
- Prospectus and Registration fee will be Rs.300/-.

ADMISSION OFFER

- Free admission for 7 days from the date of declaration of NBSE class 12 result.
- 50% concession for 5 days from the date the free admission gets over.
- 25% concession for 5 days from the date the 50% concession gets over.
- Some seats are reserved for candidates without standing academic record, sports persons and differently abled persons.
- Free hostel admission for 14 days from the date of NBSE result declaration.

ATTENDANCE

Students are required to attend all the lectures, tutorials, practical sessions, extension lectures and other programmes arranged for them. A student whose attendance falls below 80% will not be allowed to appear the pre and end semester examination.

- Leaving the college premises during the class hours is not tolerated except when the cause is sudden illness or some unforeseen circumstance for which permission should be sought from the head of institution.
- To be admitted to the classroom, absentees must show the teacher their leave record duly countersigned by the Principal/ Vice Principal/ Dean Students Welfare.
- No student is allowed to leave the college during college hours without approval from the Principal/Vice Principal.

EXAMINATIONS

It is compulsory for all the students to sit for their internal assessment and mid term examination. Students who fail in their internal assessment and pre-semester examination cannot sit for the end semester examination. Progress reports will be sent to the parents to appraise them regarding the progress of their children.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- Students are required to maintain discipline and good conduct within the college premises.
- Dress and general appearance must be in good taste. It is compulsory for all the students to wear the college uniform on all college days, unless informed otherwise.
- Smoking, chewing of pan/pan masala, as well as consumption of drugs and alcohol is prohibited within the campus.
- The use of mobile phones within the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- Communal harmony is to be preserved in words and deeds.
- Damaging and dirtying of the college property should be strictly avoided. Defaulters will have to compensate the college.
- Each student must have a college identity card and a fee coupon. The identity card and leave record book is to be brought to the college everyday and are to be produced when asked for.
- Students seeking transfer certificate during the year have to clear all the college dues up to the end of the current academic year.
- Fees once paid are not refundable.
- All terms and conditions set forth in this Prospectus, including fees and dues etc., are liable to be revised whenever necessary.

COLLEGE DATA MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (CDMS)

To simplify college management the college had signed an MOU in May 2017 with SIMS LITE. Through this software system, the management of admission, attendance, academic assessment, co-curricular activities, parents-teacher interaction etc for the college becomes easier and informative. The college signed a fresh MOU with Ramitech in the year 2022 for college management software.

HOSTEL

Secure and separate hostel accommodations for both boys and girls are available for deserving students on first come first serve basis. Seats in the hostel are allotted at the time of admission. There are 70 seats for boys and 70 seats for girls. However, admission into the college does not bestow any guarantee or rights for hostel admission. Separate rules for the hostels may be obtained on request from the office or from the hostel warden. Admission in the hostel is strictly at the discretion of the Principal.

BUS SERVICE

The college provides daily bus service for desiring students who are residing in and around PR Hill, Kohima Town, High School Junction, New Sect, Kohima College and DBS Junction. Constant Taxi service (shared or hired) is also available at North Police point.

GYMNASIUM

Besides the various co-curricular activities that runs throughout the year. The college provides gym facilities to balance their mental and physical well-being of the students.

AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS

ATTENDANCE AWARD

Students maintaining aggregate 100% attendance in each class in an academic year are eligible for the award. It carries a certificate and cash incentives.

MERITORIOUS AWARD

Meritorious Award is given to those students who secure first position with first division marks. The award carries a memento and cash incentives.

BEST GRADUATE AWARD

This award is based on overall best among the graduates.

AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

Students securing highest marks in a particular subject in Degree Examination are eligible for the award. It carries a cash award and citation.

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

B.A and B.com 1st semester students' securing 75% in the examinations can avail for the college scholarship. Five students each in BA and B.com 1st Semester can avail college scholarship and the selection will be based on merit. Selected students will get 50% off in the tuition fee in the 1st semester and that it will continue in subsequent semesters if the student secures 1st class in the end semester examination.

SPECIAL CATEGORY STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIP

Special category student's scholarship was introduced in 2016 for the degree students; one each from B.A & B.Com. The main objective of the scholarship is to provide opportunity to students from poor economic background, who has an aptitude for good academic performance, with academic record of a minimum of 75% in the HSSLC examination. The scholarship gives 50% concession on admission fee and free tuition fees. The scholarship is sponsored by the college's teaching and non-teaching staff.

Both college and special category scholarship students should maintain a minimum 80% attendance continuously to avail the scholarship.

SKILLFEST

Empowering the youth to be sustainable and productive by taking the hidden potential of our younger generation and bridging them with the available resources of the state is the core aim of the Skill Fest.

EXPOSURE TRIP

For the final year degree students, local exposure trip to a practical field of interest is organized on priority basis.
